

ESTIMATED BILLING WORKSHEET 2009-10

This worksheet is designed to help financial aid recipients estimate their quarterly invoices. In order to complete the worksheet, you will need a copy of your most recent Financial Aid Award Notice and your Residence and Board Contract. Fill in the sections highlighted in lavender. If a field does not apply to you, just leave it blank. If you complete the worksheet online, the totals will be calculated for you and you can print a copy for your records. If you choose to complete the worksheet by hand, be sure to subtract origination fees (0% - 3% depending on your lender) from any Stafford or PLUS loans you may have. You will also need to subtract the total credits from the total charges to calculate the estimated balance. To assist you, tuition and fees for 2009-10 have already been filled in, but these figures can be modified or deleted if necessary. Please remember that this worksheet is only intended to be a financial planning tool. Additional unanticipated charges or credits may be included on the actual invoice.
